This message was sent to David at work. We checked our system and the named file was indeed there...so best to treat this seriously.

The SULFNBK.EXE warning is not accurate.

There *is* a virus/worm which propagates through corrupted copies of the SULFNBK.EXE file. However, this file is a standard part of the Windows installation. If you have a copy of SULFNBK.EXE in the windows\command directory, it is almost certainly not infected. If you have a copy anywhere else, it probably *is* infected and should be deleted.
