There is also ST. SCANDALBAGS, which slams critics.

Amanda Ros was famous for hating critics and lawyers; thus it makes perfect sense, seeing as how she wrote DONALD, that she would also pen a book blasting lawyers.

Hence the rationale for THE LUSTY LAWYER.

Looking over the titles, with an eye toward PEACE (please don't forget that the =only= occurrence of the word "peace" in PEACE is in the Ros forgery!), I will admit that I'm a little uneasy about "Delina," since A.D. Weer's mom's name is Adelina, aka "Della."
