It's quite short, under 2000 words, and to my mind it's fairly minor Wolfe. It's about a woman, a nurse, exhumed because people suspect she was murdered, and a letter she wrote that was buried with her, detailing her curious relationship with a patient.

I was confused by some bits of the story, but the confusion did not, for me, have the overtones of Wolfean confusion -- that is, confusion that on further thought and rereading will be dispelled to be replaced with some form of wonder or admiration. However, maybe further thought and rereading is what is required.
