To coincide with the launch of the second edition of the *_Lexicon Urthus_*, the editors of Ultan's Library are pleased to announce the publication of a new essay by Michael Andre-Driussi entitled "The Death of Catherine the Weal and Other Stories".

The essay, which was originally written in 1992 for inclusion in John Clute's proposed collection of critical essays on Gene Wolfe, refutes the suggestion made by both Clute and Gregory Feeley that Severian's mother Catherine was also the Old Autarch. It also examines the mystery of the Old Autarch's anonymity within *_The Book of the New Sun_* and searches for the true identities of some of the key women in Severian's life.

The editors of Ultan's Library also hope to publish an interview with Michael Andre-Driussi about the new edition of his *Lexicon* in the very near future.
