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Once in the Corridors, he may be able to travel any distance on either Fountain-power or human muscle power, and then step down into the normal world of four dimensions. But without the White Fountain or a similar power source to draw on, he can't go back up to the Corridors. It may be that he decides to write URTH at all because with the White Fountain contained, concealed, or even consumed by the new sun, he is stuck in the early time centuries of Ushas , and is making the best of his forced retirement from saviorhood.
