You will not get any more messages from this list until you re-enable your membership. You will receive 3 more reminders like this before your membership in the list is deleted."

The term 'bounce' is abacadabra to me. Anybody knows?

The messages being sent out from the Urth list are being bounced back to the server you might not be receiving them. Like a returned letter.

I'm getting that too. It sounds like it's the list's hosting, rather than you that's the problem.

"Bounce" usually means the message wasn't deliverable for some reason. It's not a technical term.
