They are called the four-eyed fish (Anableps species). (Duh!) It wasn't too hard to find this out when I looked for "four-eyed fish" instead of "fish with double-pupiled, segmented eyes". They live in the rivers of eastern South America and grow to be a foot long. My description was pretty accurate; I'll just add the detail that their eyes are on the top of their head, like a frog, so only the top half of their eyes stick out of the water.
